From 1915 to 1932, over 5,300 Rosenwald schools were constructed. In 1954, when the Supreme Court declared segregation in education unconstitutional, Rosenwald schools became obsolete.

The Rosenwald Fund contributed one-third of the NAACP's litigation costs aimed at school desegregation in *Brown vs. Board of Education*.



The National Trust for Historic Preservation declared Rosenwald schools National Treasures in 2011.

Recently, alumni and local communities have come together to preserve their history and restore the schools for community use.

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The Michigan Boulevard Garden Apartments, renamed the Rosenwald Courts, were restored and reopened in October of 2016.



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Julius Rosenwald's children and their cousins, the Adlers, rescued 300 relatives from Nazi Germany and helped settle and educate them in America.
